

What is ICS2?

ICS2 is a new IT system created to collect data about all goods entering the EU prior to their arrival. Economic Operators will have to declare safety and security data to ICS2, through the Entry Summary Declaration.

The system aims to better protect Europe's single market and its citizens with new customer safety and security measures and will facilitate free flow of trade through improved data-driven customs security processes, adapted to global business models.

ICS2 Fee (EU Imports)

The fee varies depending on whether NTEX provides the declaration service.

For freight

- from the United Kingdom to Sweden
- from Sweden to Ireland via United Kingdom
- or from the United Kingdom to Ireland

the ICS2 fee applies as follows:

DAP (Delivered at Place)

- If NTEX creates the export declaration, a fee of £35 applies, which covers both the export declaration and the ICS2 declaration as a single fee. The export declaration should not be charged separately. The fee is payable by the freight payer in the UK.
- If the customer or agent creates the export declaration, a fee of £20 applies for ICS2-related costs, payable by the freight payer.

FCA (Free Carrier – Swedish Freight Payer)

- If NTEX creates the export declaration, a fee of £35 applies, which covers both the export declaration and the ICS2 declaration as a single fee. The export declaration should not be charged separately. The fee is payable by the seller of the goods. The freight payer does not pay a separate ICS2 fee.
- If the customer or agent creates the export declaration, a fee of £20 applies for ICS2-related costs, payable by the Swedish freight payer.

EXW (Ex Works – Swedish Freight Payer)

- If NTEX creates the export declaration, a fee of £35 applies, which covers both the export declaration and the ICS2 declaration as a single fee. The export declaration should not be charged separately. The fee is payable by the freight payer, in this case, the Swedish customer.
- If the customer or agent creates the export declaration, a fee of £20 applies for ICS2-related costs, payable by the Swedish freight payer.

Surcharge:

- £35 = SEK 480 / EUR 42
- £20 = SEK 275 / EUR 24
